<p><i>Shirts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• White, black or burgundy polo shirts (long or short sleeved) <p><i>*Shirts must be long enough to stay tucked into pants with a belt at all times.</i></p>
<p><i>Pants or Shorts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Khaki classic cut long pants, no cargo pockets• Khaki classic cut knee-length shorts, no cargo pockets• Khaki jumpers or skirts are appropriate for girls as long as length meets requirements <p><i>*Shorts or skirts with hems that are more than two inches above the knee will not be allowed.</i></p>
<p><i>Outerwear:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Burgundy, black or white sweatshirts without hoods, collars must show• Burgundy, black or white sweaters and button up cardigans, collars must show• Burgundy, black or white sweater vests• Heavy winter coats may be worn to school <u>but not worn throughout the building and during instruction in the classroom</u>• Light jackets outside of the uniform policy are not permissible in the classroom or building during instructional hours. Please see above for approved outerwear.
<p><i>Belts:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Brown or black leather with no embellished buckle
<p><i>Socks and Shoes:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No knee socks with shorts• Closed toed and closed heeled shoes, no light up shoes.• No sandals, flip flops, slippers, slip-on ballerina flats without a strap, for safety reasons• Shoes may not be above the ankle, no light up or sequined shoes• Solid black, burgundy, white ankle or crew cut socks with shorts, pants, jumpers, and skirts <p>OPTIONAL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Black, burgundy, white tights under jumpers and skirts• Solid black, burgundy, white knee socks with jumpers and skirts

Accessories are not permissible including but not limited to:

- Jewelry that distracts from learning during instructional hours will be confiscated by teachers and returned at the end of the instructional day.
- Purses will not be permissible in grades CD-3.
- Purses in grades 4-6 must be kept in book bags or lockers and will not be allowed out during the instructional day including recess, meals, and activities outside of the classroom during these hours.
- Winter accessories, gloves, scarves, hats, mittens must be put away when instruction begins.
- No wristbands, armbands
- No sunglasses or non-prescription eyewear accessories are permissible.
- Headphones
- Headbands, ribbons and other hair accessories must be burgundy, white, or black.
